### Eligibility

To be eligible, each researcher must simultaneously fulfill the following criteria at the time of recruitment by the beneficiary concerned in the frame of this project.

#### (a) Nationality

The researcher may be of any nationality.

#### (b) Mobility

At the time of recruitment by the beneficiary, the researcher must not have resided or carried out his/her main activity (work, studies, etc...) in the country of the beneficiary for more than 12 months in the 3 years immediately prior to his/her recruitment under the project. Compulsory national service and/or short stays such as holidays are not taken into account.

As far as international European interest organizations or international organizations are concerned, this rule does not apply to the hosting of eligible researchers, however, the appointed researcher must not have spent more than 12 months in the 3 years immediately prior to the recruitment by the beneficiary in the same recruiting organization.

### Salary:

- Gross living allowance of about 60.000,00 €/year (the net salary results from deducting all compulsory social security contributions -employee's contribution and employer's contribution, where applicable- as well as direct taxes -e.g. income tax- from the gross amounts).
- mobility allowance: this is a monthly payment of a flat rate contribution to cover expenses related to the mobility (relocation, family expenses, language courses, travel expenses etc.), for a maximum of 10.883,00 €/year, plus:
- SPRIN will receive a contribution to the research/transfer of knowledge program expenses of the eligible experienced researcher. This contribution is managed by the host organization (SPRIN) for expenses related to the participation of the experienced researcher in research and transfer of knowledge activities. In principle this cover all costs related to the successful execution of the project by the fellow (e.g. purchase of consumables, participation in conferences and training courses, fees for scientific journals, memberships of scientific associations etc.). SPRIN have a maximum of 21.000,00 €/year for this.

## Training program

One of the main goals of the project is to train researches, so you can absolutely take part in conferences and workshops. Within the project main training events and conferences that will be organized/participated will be:

- Scientific workshop on green chemistry organized by the Dublin City University
- Summer school and conference organized by the Dublin City University
- Participation to Biotrans 2013
- Industrial practice workshop on Business Development and IP organized by SPRIN and DSM
- Industrial practice workshop on Industrial Biotechnology organized by SPRIN and CRODA

At the end of the project a “Career training” organized by the University of Nottingham will take place.

Moreover, the researcher will be allowed to participate to other conferences, congresses and similar, related to his/her work.

## Living expenses in Trieste

To rent a flat (i.e kitchen, bathroom, living room and at least one bedroom), the expenses are usually about 500 €/month plus consumptions (water, gas ecc., usually about 50 €/month) – but consider that it possible to find also cheaper places. To rent a single room usually the price is around 150-250 €/month plus consumptions (divided among all the people living in the apartment). If there is internet in the apartment, (or if you want to put it), usually you can have 24h connection for 20€/month.

Other expenses examples: with 24 €/month you can use every bus line. Consider that in Trieste there are lot of students, so find a flat or a room to rent is quite easy.
