3. A Transcript of Records will be issued by the receiving institution no later than 4 weeks after the assessment period has finished at the receiving HEI.

4. Termination of the agreement

In case of unilateral termination, a notice of at least one academic year should be given. This means that a unilateral decision to discontinue the exchanges notified to the other party by 1 September 2019 will only take effect as of 1 September 2019+1. "Neither the European Commission nor the National Agencies can be held responsible in case of a conflict."

1. Grading systems of the institutions
