





Zdravko Schauperl is full professor at the University of Zagreb, the Faculty of Mechanical Engineering and Naval Architecture (FAMENA). After graduation in 1989 from FAMENA he worked in the company "Montmontaža" and since 1991 he works at the Department of Materials, FAMENA. He achieved his M.Sc. degree in 1996. After that he made a scientific mission in the VITO institute, Belgium, carrying out research in the scope of his Ph.D. thesis. He acquired his Ph. D. in 2001. from university of Zagreb. Since 1997 he is the head of the Laboratory of Materialography at the Department of Materials.

He is the head lecturer of a number of courses at the undergraduate and graduate study, as well as two courses at doctoral study at FAMENA. Since 2008 he is a head of Materials Engineering programme at the same faculty.

He is also involved in the teaching of the course Materials in dentistry at School of dentistry, University of Zagreb. Since 2010 he is Croatian delegate in the COST programme of European Council in Domain of materials, physics and nano-science.

He was a president of Croatian Society for Materials and Tribology and Croatian Society for LPG. He is a member of Croatian Welding Society, Croatian Microscopy Society and Centre for Non-destructive testing.

He was actively involved in organization of more than 15 domestic and international conferences In 2001 he was awarded with the Arnold H. Graves postdoctoral fellowship from Dublin Institute of Technology, Dublin, Ireland, where he spent a year as a postdoctoral researcher. In 2009 he was awarded with FAMENA medal for his activities. He was invited lecturer at four congresses.

He has published over 90 scientific papers, technical reports and expertises.

He has participated as a researcher at several scientific and technology projects, and has led several scientific projects and R&D projects for industry.
